Ram of Consecration

Washing

Aaron and sons washed with water

Clothing

Wearing of tunic, robe of ephod, ephod, breastplate, band, turban, holy crown, anointing of oil, tunics and sashes on Aaron's sons

Sin Offering

Aaron and sons put hands on bull, kill bull, apply blood on horns of altar, pour blood beside base of altar, burn bull's fat on altar, flesh, skin, offal burned outside camp

Burnt Offering

Aaron and sons put hands on one ram, kill the ram, sprinkle blood around altar, cut ram in pieces, wash entrails and legs, entire ram is burnt on altar

Apply Blood

Aaron and sons put hands on other ram, kill the ram, apply blood to their right ear, right thumb, right big toe,

Anointing Oil and Blood

Take some blood from altar and anointing oil, sprinkle on Aaron and sons to hallow them

Wave and Heave Offering

Fat of the ram, one loaf of bread, one cake made with oil, wafer, and right thigh are put into hands of Aaron and sons and waved before the LORD and burnt on the altar. The breast is waved and thigh is raised before the LORD.

Bread and flesh eaten

Flesh of the ram and bread in the basket must be eaten at the door of tabernacle. Strangers may not eat because it's holy. Any remaining till morning must be burnt.

Exodus 29:30,32,35,36 [Lev 8:33-35]

Holy garments must be worn for seven days, seven days to consecrate them, the bull [sin offering] is offered daily for atonement, remain at the door of the tabernacle night and day for seven days continually.

“Consecration” in the Scriptures

Qadash (קִדַּשׁ)

.....
Consecrate, hallow, set apart, treated as sacred, make holy
[Ex 29:1, 21, 27, 33, 36, 37; Lev 8:10, 11, 12, 15, 30]

Consecration of the priests

- Ex 29:1 - hallow (consecrate) them for ministering to Me as priests
- Ex 29:20-21 - ...so he and his garments shall be consecrated.

Consecration of Israel

- Ex 19:10 - The LORD also said to Moses, “Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their garments.”

Consecration of the tabernacle

- Ex 29:44 - I will consecrate the temple of meeting and the altar; I will consecrate Aaron and his sons to minister as priests to Me

Consecration of the people

- Lev 11:44 - For I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves there, and be holy, for I am holy

Malé/Millû (מָלָא)

.....
To fill (so that there's no more lack) or fulfill, accomplish, making complete
[Ex 29:22, 26, 27, 31, 34; Lev 8:22, 28, 29, 31, 33]

Consecration of the priests

- Ex 29:9 - so you shall **consecrate** (fill the hand of) Aaron
 - given everything they need to do the work as priests
- Ex 29:35 - thus you shall do to Aaron and to his sons, according to all that I have commanded you; you shall **consecrate** (fill their hand) them through seven days (daily consecration)
- Num 3:3 - these are the names of the sons of Aaron, the anointed priests, whom he **consecrated** (filled their hand) to minister as priests

For the Building of the Tabernacle

- Ex 31:2-3 - “See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. And I have **filled** him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,
- Ex 40:35 - And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD **filled** the tabernacle

“Consecration” in the Scriptures

Consecration - separated to God as holy

.....

Eph 4:22-24 - Put off the old man, be renewed in the spirit of the mind, put on the new man

Rom 6:11-14, 16-18, 20-23 - We were set free from sin, and became slaves of righteousness, slaves of God

1 Cor 6:20 - We were bought at a price

Gal 2:20 - Died with Christ

Matt 16:24 - Denying of self, taking up cross, following Christ

Phil 3:7-11 - Counting all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus

Consecration - to be filled by God

.....

Fullness of God in Christ

- **John 1:16-17** - of His fullness we have all received and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ
- **Col 2:9-10** - in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and we are complete in Him
- **Eph 1:3, 19** - He has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ; exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe
- **Phil 4:13, 19** - I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. My God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus

Holy Spirit as the Anointing

- **John 16:13** - Spirit of truth will guide you into all truth
- **1 John 2:27** - the anointing abides in you, and teaches you concerning all things..
- **2 Tim 1:7** - Spirit of power, love, and a sound mind

Consecrated to carry out God's plan on earth

Against God's enemy

Ex 3:8; 19:5-6 - Israel as a kingdom of priests to take over the promised land

Ps 8; Rev 1:5,6; 5:9-10 - We are called to rule in God's righteousness

Matt 16:18-19; Hab 2:14; Rev 21:11 - Manifest God's glory, righteousness, kingdom on earth

Gen 1:28; Rev 11:15 - Retake, rule over, and subdue the earth

Ezek 44:24; 1 Cor 6:2-3 - Judge the nations

Zeal of the priests

Ex 32:28 - Levites with zeal of the Lord kill 3,000 idolatrous Israelites

- Levites were rewarded with the priesthood

Num 25:11-13 - Phineas the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, has turned back My wrath from the children of Israel, because he was zealous with My zeal among them, so that I did not consume the children of Israel in My zeal.

Psalms 110 - Christ, the High Priest, executing judgment against kings and the nations

Psalms 149 - His saints have the honor of executing His judgment

Rev 19:11-21 - Christ in priestly garments riding into war
